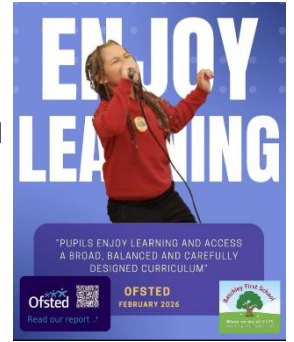

Talk about family rules and why they help keep everyone on track and safe.

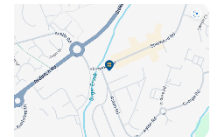
Special Visitor
